I understand that a proper riding helmet and boots are necessary safety equipment for any equine activity and I take full responsibility for providing and for the wearing of such equipment while so engaged, if parent or legal guardian chooses not to provide their child with such safety equipment, by signing this release, parent/legal guardian gives consent and confirms that the use of such safety equipment is not necessary for your child and therefore you take full responsibility for this decision as the parent or legal guardian.

Riding Student Lesson Terms and Policies

1. All lessons will be assigned to the instructor we feel is best suited to provide the instruction. We reserve the right to substitute instructors as we deem appropriate. If you have any questions or concerns regarding the instructor assigned to your lesson, please discuss them with the Ranch Manager. We also reserve the right to teach multiple students at the same time as we deem appropriate. We do not guarantee individual or private lessons.
2. We will select the horse we deem appropriate to the student and the day's lesson. This includes the right to change horses as we think best in the interest of the safety of the lesson and the day's goals for the lesson.
3. Riding Lessons will average one hour in length. However each individual lesson is objective based, not time based and the actual length of instruction may vary depending on the student's progress that particular day.
4. Your appointed day and time are when your lessons have been scheduled for. This is the block of time you have paid for and the block of time we have set aside for you. If you are late for the appointed time, that time may be taken out of your lesson. For example, if your lesson is at 10:00 AM and you arrive at 10:20, the ending time for your lesson is still 11:00 and your available lesson will be reduced accordingly. This includes any time spent grooming the assigned horse.
5. **All cancellations require 48 hours notice.** If you do not provide 48 hours notice for a cancellation, your lesson may be forfeited. With 48 hours notice we will do everything we can to reschedule the missed lesson but it is subject to availability and must be rescheduled within 30 days of the missed lesson. We limit make ups to 1 per month. **We do not guarantee availability to reschedule but will do our best.**
6. Parents and family are invited and encouraged to watch lessons, but please do not participate without prior approval. This includes but is not limited to helping to groom and tack the horse or to helping explain any part of the lesson during the lesson. Please let the instructor do their job without interference or distraction. If you have any questions or concerns, feel free to discuss them with the Ranch Manager or senior staff but please do not interrupt the instructor during a lesson.
7. Our primary goal is that the student be able to participate in horse activities as safely as possible taking into consideration that such activities horses are inherently dangerous. Next is that they enjoy the activity and finally that they learn the necessary skills to accomplish their individual and personal goals. To that end we encourage all students to discuss their individual goals with the instructor and ranch management on a regular basis so that the lesson plan can be tuned to those individual goals.
8. Lesson payments are due on the anniversary day of each month regardless of any missed lessons. If you started on the 8th, you are due by the 8th of each month. Anyone not paying on time may be charged a late fee of \$10 per week or may lose their spot in the lesson schedule. There are no refunds on any prepaid lessons.
9. At any time there are questions or concerns, please bring them to the attention of the Ranch Manager.
10. **This agreement is month to month and may be cancelled at any time with 30 days notice by either party.** Less than 30 days notice on the part of the student will result in the student still being due for a month's lessons.

RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of the acceptance of my participation and/or the participation of my child or ward, in the renting of a horse from or related activities offered by the Haven Horse Ranch, and with the understanding that a horse may be startled by sudden movement, noise or other factors, and may shy suddenly, rear, stop short, bite, buck, kick or run with its rider, especially when the ride is conducted through an unnatural setting, as this activity will be, I AGREE TO ASSUME THE RISKS incidental to such participation including, but not limited to, those risks set out above, and, on my own behalf, on behalf of my child or ward, and on behalf of my child's or ward's heirs, executors and administrators, RELEASE and forever discharge the released parties defined below, of and from all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any nature, arising out of or in any way connected with my participation and/or the participation of my child or ward in such horseback riding or related activities and further agree to indemnify and hold each of the released parties harmless against any and all such liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses, including, but not limited to, attorney's fees and disbursements. The released parties are the Haven Horse Ranch, their parent, related, affiliated and subsidiary companies, and the officers, directors, employees, agents, representatives, successors and assigns of each. I understand that this release and indemnity agreement includes any claims based on the negligence, actions or inaction of any of the above released parties and covers bodily injury and property damage, whether suffered by me, my child or ward before, during, or after such participation. I further authorize medical treatment for said child or ward, at my cost, if the need arises.
